

READ Galatians 3:7-16

Here are some questions and thoughts to help guide discussion:

- 1. Did anything stand out to you about this week's sermon? Was there anything that surprised you, or that was new to you?
- 2. In Galatians 3:8, Paul says that the gospel was preached to Abraham. What is the gospel, according to this verse? What are the implications of viewing the gospel as a "blessing"? (See also Acts 3:25-26). How might this perspective impact the way we view evangelism and missions?
- 3. God promised Abraham that he and his descendant(s) would be a blessing to the nations. How was/is that blessing taken to the nations? What is our role in making that happen? What are you doing to bring that blessing to the nations?
- 4. Isn't it ironic that even though we in Canada are largely failing to *go* to all the nations, the nations are coming here, to us, as immigrants? What is your heart for the immigrants that are coming to Canada? How would your perspective on immigration change if you thought like a citizen of the Kingdom of God, not just of Canada?
- 5. Do you think Pastor Chris is right in saying that racism is a problem in the Canadian church? Have you seen or experienced it? Do you perceive it in your own heart? If so, what can you do about it?
- 6. In Matthew 28:19-20, Jesus commanded us to bring the gospel to all nations. Does your heart yearn for the kingdom of God to be spread? What can you do, even this week, to help make this happen?
