Ephesians 2:11-22 Galatians 3:28-29 Romans 11:11-26 Colossians 3:9-15

Here are some questions and thoughts to help guide discussion:

- 1. Did anything stand out to you about this week's sermon? Was anything particularly helpful? Was anything particularly challenging?
- 2. What has been your perspective on the relationship between Israel and the church? Does Ephesians 2:11-22 (or any of our other passages this morning) support that view, or cause you to question it?
- 3. Do you see yourself in the way that Ephesians 2:19 describes you, or is this a change in perspective? What does this perspective mean for you?
- 4. Romans 11:18, 20 & 26 speak about the humility we Gentiles should have.

 Describe how this works. How will all this truth produce humility in you this week?
- 5. In Colossians 3:9-15, where do we see the connection between our behaviour and our membership in the people of God?
- 6. To what degree do you think you've been impacted by an individualized, "Jesus and me" view of Christianity? What would practically change in your life if you truly saw yourself as a part of a people, the people of God? Put another way, what parts of Colossians 3:9-15 do you most need God's help to apply?
- 7. How can your fellow brothers and sisters pray for and help you in this regard?
