

READ Matthew 6:19-21 1 Timothy 6:17-19

Here are some questions and thoughts to help guide discussion:

- 1. Did anything stand out to you about this week's sermon? Was there anything that surprised you, or that was new to you?
- 2. When we were asked what a godly person looks like, what kind of person came to your mind? Were they more wealthy or poor? How have you always thought godly people should respond to the matter of money and possessions?
- 3. How does our society view money and possessions? How do you think this has affected how we in the church views money and possessions?
- 4. Read Deuteronomy 28:2-5, Matthew 6:19-21, and Philippians 4:11-13. On Sunday, we saw that the Old and New Covenants deal with physical blessing differently. How did you react to this? Had you seen the difference there before?
- 5. Read 1 Timothy 6:17-19. How are those who have material wealth supposed to act? Do you see yourselves as having material wealth? If so, how can you use that to be "rich in good works"?
- 6. Read Matthew 6:19-21. Where do you think the majority of your treasures lay? On earth, or in heaven? What are you doing, and what can you do to store up more treasures in heaven?
