

READ Ephesians 6:10-20

Here are some questions and thoughts to help guide discussion:

- 1. Did anything stand out to you about this week's sermon? Was there anything that surprised you, or that was new to you?
- 2. How have you typically thought of "spiritual warfare"? Who or what has influenced your understanding of spiritual warfare the most? Did this morning's message affirm what you've believed, or lead you to reconsider some things in light of God's word?
- 3. What do we learn about spiritual warfare in Genesis 3:1-5? What does this passage show us about Satan's tactics? Think of some times when Satan has used these tactics in your life. How does it help to think of those times as "spiritual warfare"?
- 4. Read or review Job 1 & 2. What do these chapters tell us about Satan's power in relation to God's? What conclusions for our own lives should we draw from this?
- 5. Review Ephesians 6:10-20. According to this passage, in what ways are you *already* engaging in spiritual warfare? What are some ways you need to more intentionally engage in spiritual warfare, as defined by these verses?
- 6. Think of one time in the upcoming week when you can expect to encounter spiritual warfare. What are you going to do to prepare for that?
- 7. We are not individual soldiers, but an army. Think of ways we can apply Ephesians 6:10-20 *together*. What are some practical ways, this week, that you can help the others in your small group fight this battle well?
